I want to extend our sincere appreciation for the continued support of the citizens of the Town of Bolton. Through community partnership, our department was recently recognized with a Silver award from AAA Southern New England for accomplishments in resolving key traffic safety issues. With the support of our Town's citizens groups and the Board of Selectmen, crosswalk locations were upgraded on Main Street, in school zones, and throughout the community, in order to make them more visible. Crosswalks were repainted and signs promoting pedestrian safety were installed. Our Officers also completed a road signage survey and inventory around the town, which included the location of existing stop and yield signs. The Officers' suggested upgrades and changes to these locations were presented to the Selectmen in June 2003, which resulted in a project coordinated among the Police Department, Highway Department and the Town Clerk. All the areas addressed in the survey were updated with new signage. This was the result of promoting pedestrian safety in partnership with the Town and the police.

Working in partnership with our citizens of Bolton is a priority of this Department. With mutual respect and understanding our department's highest priorities are to respond promptly and professionally to the concerns and needs of our Community. It is the continued goal of our department to promote civic awareness with continued strengthening of partnership between the Town and the police.
