The applicant is seeking a Comprehensive Permit to construct eight (8) units of homeownership housing pursuant to M.G.L. c.40B. The development will consist of four (4) two-unit duplex style buildings located on two lots each containing two (2) duplex buildings. In conformance with M.G.L. c. 40B, the development will contain two (2) affordable units.
