## Agenda:

- Minutes Tabled for next meeting
- Meet with Randy Heglin re; building and grounds updates
  - Sewer Repair: No bids; will have to go out to rebid;
    - Contractors are busy; small project with a lot of moving pieces not that attractive
    - Probably over winter 2022; seeking feedback from potential bidder (late fall, early winter)
  - o Current Projects
    - Parking lot pavement and re-lining is complete
    - Window repairs are still in progress
  - Municipal Building Assessment
    - See: "Bolton Massachusetts Municipal Building Conditions Assessment Report, Town of Bolton, June 2022 Final."
    - Division of Labor
      - Trustees to take lead on item L-S-7 Library, Exterior,
        Structural/Architectural, Repair to original library windows, estimated at \$750K
        - O Timing: B 6-10 years
          - Consensus is that we should get started on this sooner rather than later
        - Architect options:
          - Original project architect (Dreyton F)
          - Architect who did Portico of Town Hall
      - DPW to take lead on all others
    - Review of "Immediate" category Items currently prioritized for coming FY
      - Emergency Lighting: More than "just" Emergency floodlights on exit;
        - Need full egress lighting w/o generator
        - Kelly: there is an emergency lighting circuit;
        - o Randy: explore possibility of battery backup for just this circuit
      - Lighting Control
        - Working w/ Payne Sparkman on a plan
      - Sealing holes to prevent insect/animal incursion

- PC: (Hopefully) this will include exclusion efforts for small critters (e.g. flying squirrels) which have been a recurring issue.
- o Humidity in Building
  - Randy has documented excessive humidity buildup in the building during "off" hours.
  - Working w/ Burnell to understand reasons
  - If necessary, Kelly has authority and can change "occupied" vs. "unoccupied" modes to perform tests
