SEPTIC PERMITS:

- 34 Fox Run Road permit extension request
 - Bill has not received request
- 133 Vaughn Hill Road bldg. file, bedrooms
 - There is no pre-existing septic plan
 - Owner and assessor do not have matching plans
 - o What will the board will respect for the number of bedrooms for the upgrade?
 - Owner's sketch shows 7 room total, Bill's sketch has 8 total rooms as existing plan
 - System is designed for 4 bedrm, there is a lot of shallow ledge on the property, there is a drilled well on the property
 - Upgrade to the system
 - o C.Rogers accepts that it is a 4 bdrm home according to the plans presented
 - What is the action next? What should the house be considered?
 - Variance is 74ft vs 100ft from well
 - o S.Powell, we should not go on the assessors report that only shows 2
 - Well test will be required per the Bolton Regulations before completion of upgrade
 - This will be an improvement
