PUBLIC HEARINGS AND APPOINTMENTS

7:00pm The Conservation Commission opened the Public Meeting. The first Public Hearing addressed the Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation for lot 31 Nashaway Road. The applicant Molly Obendorf of Stansky and McNary had sent an email to request a continuance until the next Conservation Commission Meeting. Present at the meeting were all abutters of the property.

Chair Brian made a motion to continue the public hearing to the next Conservation Commission meeting July 31st at 7:15pm. Jeff seconded, all unanimously approve.

The commission discussed the request to leave the area which was meant to be treeline as grass. The commission took a poll, establishing that the treeline is required and a planting plan should be submitted to the concom by the contractor for restoring that area from grass to treeline per the original plans.

The commission voted unanimously to accept the new member Chris McNamara.

The commission establishes that they are ok with a shed to replace the one which was at the “home base” of the camp with one that is relatively the same size but not significantly larger.

Chair Brian makes a motion to approve the minutes for June 19th 2018 as drafted with a change of the next meeting date from “July 24th” to “July 31st”. Jeff seconded, all unanimously approve.
