**PUBLIC HEARINGS AND APPOINTMENTS**

REQUEST FOR A DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY (RDA); NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI), ABBREVIATED  
NOTICE OF RESOURCE AREA DELINEATION (ANRAD), ORDER OF CONDITIONS (OOC)

The Conservation Commission ( “the commission”) continued the public hearing regarding the Notice of Intent regarding Lot 31 Nashaway Road. The DEP file number has yet to be issued therefore the applicant requested via email prior to the public meeting that the public hearing be continued until the conservation commissions next public meeting.

Chair Brian made a motion to continue the public hearing of Lot 31 Nashaway Road until March 6<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 7:00pm. Jeff seconded, all unanimously approve.

Chair Brian makes a motion to approve the minutes drafted for the meeting which took place February 5<sup>th</sup> 2019. Emily seconded, all unanimously approve.

The commission reviewed the remediation plan for Danforth Brook (from the event of January 24<sup>th</sup> 2019 sourced at Keyes Farm). The Commission took a poll to authorize the Conservation Agent to approve the plan when it is drafted to include sufficient practices to remediate the adverse impacts.

The commission has been approached regarding an opportunity to host “Tinkergarten”. The commission has requested the Conservation Agent reach out to the representative to have them attend a meeting to discuss the practices, policies, and classes proposed. In addition the commission will review policies at their next meeting.

The next meeting dates are tentatively scheduled for: March 6<sup>th</sup> 2019, March 19<sup>th</sup> 2019.

The Commission discussed the request for certificate of compliance regarding 1 Century Mill Road. The applicant’s representative has requested a continuance until the next public meeting of the Conservation Commission. The discussion has been continued until March 6<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 7:15pm.

Chair Brian makes a motion to close the Public Meeting of the Conservation Commission on February 19<sup>th</sup> 2019. Jeff seconded, all unanimously approve.
