Meeting Minutes December 6, 2021

Bolton Robotics:

Bolton Robotics Team joined to present their plan for helping people shop locally. They surveyed the town, as well as some local businesses, and created a website called Bolton Buy Local

EDC agreed that this would be a useful website to link into our destination Bolton site. The site is currently blocked by the school's firewall, so will need to be replicated before it can be handed off to the EDC for use and maintenance going forward.

The team stated they will only be able to continue maintaining the webpage through the end of their current season.

Unclear at this point whether the intent is for residential or business, but the EDC would work with the new owner to help them if their intent is to open a business there. Not currently a business district, so that may be an obstacle. Further research is needed.
