I. Minutes: Minutes for 2/6/19 were reviewed and approved.

II. Updates

- Still River Commons: A ZBA meeting to discuss this development will be held at 7:00 this evening. As many members of the Commission as can will attend this meeting.
- Cloud Viewpoint: This is the new system for permitting in town. Bob Busch has tried it and found it works well.
- Brick Store: At a recent meeting the Board of Health said that the septic system for that building would not be able to tap into the main serving town buildings. It would continue to use a "tight tank" system.
- East End NRHD project: Anne Forbes is to start her work on that project shortly.
- MassWorks project: The Commission is keeping current with the work proposed at the intersection of Main St. and Wattaquadock Hill Rd. We will be in touch with MHC about this work as there are historic buildings on all sides of the intersection and it is in a NRHD. There may be some possibility of restricting the access of the largest trucks to this intersection.

Budget: The Commission discussed several projects to be funded out of the current fiscal year's budget-

- Repair or replacement of damaged bollards at Pan Cemetery
- Metal markers for the graves of Civil War veterans at various cemeteries
- Partial payment to Anne Forbes for work on the East End NRHD.
- Contribution to the cost of a new fence at School Pond
- Employment of outside help in digitizing some of the Commission's photo archives.

IV. New Topics: The Commission looked at the proposed plan for an easement at Persons Park for utilities access (water, electric and sewer). It is important that it not impinge on existing wetland setbacks.

There was discussion of the need to send minutes to Google Drive as well as to individual Commission members.
