## 3. Updates:

- a. **Keyes Farm house plaque**: This will be 15" x 10". The order has been approved and placed.
- **b. Wilder Culvert plaque:** From Paul Zimmerman Foundry, 12" x 8 " mounted by Hathaway Memorials on a Barre granite post. The order was approved.
- c. Pan Cemetery: Four replacement bollards of the type we have, normally \$600 each plus shipping, are available. The Commission will inquire if the supplier can provide a discount on the bollards or free shipping. There was also discussion of ways to protect the bollards from being hit.
- **d. Flag Holders:** The Commission approved the purchase of 32 aluminum marker/flag holders for the graves of Civil War veterans.
- **e. Pan Cemetery retaining wall:** DPW has not responded after our letter last winter. F.C. Chiodo, Jr. excavating could be called for an estimate to the retaining wall repair.
- f. Keyes House: Bob Busch reported on his recent visit and tour of the house at Keyes' Farm. Work is going on there as the developer does not get permits for new houses until work is done on the original 1728 house. The work appears well done and has involved work on the walls and ceilings.
- 4. Mail: Town Clerk provided a basic training manual for Virtual Towns and Schools.
