- 4. **Persons Park** B. Busch sent Ed Sterling the write up he did on the Persons Park proposal. He hasn't heard anything back yet, so we will continue this discussion to the August meeting.
- 5. **Meeting Minutes** The following meeting minutes have been approved: Oct.7, 2020; Nov. 4, 2020; Dec. 9, 2020; May 5, 2021 and June 16, 2021. J. Padovano will convert them to PDF and save them to the final draft folder.
- 6. **New Member process -** Nate Smith indicated that he is interested in joining the BHC and will write a letter stating his interest in volunteering on the commission. M. Remington will bring the letter to the Selectmens' meeting for formal appointment.
- 7. **Anne Forbes** joined our meeting. She sent a Form A draft for the new East End historic district. Commissioners will review this and then will try to get information put into the paper. The new district should be accurately named according to historic records. Traditionally this area was called The East End. Other options could be Bolton East End. Commissioners voted to refer to this area as Bolton East End.
