The Bolton Police Department is pleased to announce the start of a Citizens Police Academy. The Academy will run from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., for eight consecutive Wednesdays, beginning October 11, 2017.

The Citizen Police Academy is designed to familiarize citizens with the operation and functions of the Bolton Police Department. Classes will cover various topics such as Criminal Law, Patrol Procedures, Evidence Collection, Domestic Violence, Motor Vehicle Enforcement, Court Procedures, and Use of Force. Additionally, participants will complete a two hour police ride along, and a tour of the Fire and EMS Departments. The ride along will allow each student to observe Police Officers while on patrol. Classes will be taught by Bolton Police Staff and Supervisors.

There is no charge to attend. Applicants must be at least eighteen years old and a resident of Bolton. The class is limited to twenty participants. Applications may be picked up at the Bolton Police Department, 15 Wattaquaddock Hill Road. Applications can also be downloaded on the Town of Bolton website.
