Pole markers were priced at 1-\$18.95, 3-\$17.95, 5-to19@16.95 It was decided to purchase 6 markers as long as we had budget money left. Sampson Rd., Hudson Rd. and Manor Rd. stop signs will get the first installment of pole markers. Mike will contact DPW. We are tasked with coming up with more intersections that will be deemed necessary for more pole markers.

The police department had only one Traffic Enforcement Form filled out and that was for the intersection of State route 110 and Main St. Would Bolton facebook page be the avenue to make town folk aware of this form? Usually they go to Town Hall to express their concerns. Bolton PD was awarded \$11,748 in a Municipal Road Safety Grant. \$5,692 will go towards the purchase of one pole mounted speed radar unit, two Speed 30 flashing signs, and one hand held radar unit. The remaining funds will go towards wages for the department.

Sampson Rd. signs on Rt.117 still a concern with over signage for the intersection.

Don Lowe will be contacted to join us at the next zoom meeting on Feb. 24 at 11am-12 noon or what time best suits his schedule. Topics to discuss: PWSC meeting with Randy, strips for poles, interview with newspaper, Mass Works funding, Complete Streets-next phase, truck exclusion sign, the school signs at the high school working at odd hours and is there a problem with the cost of the new intersection light?
