Approved and signed minutes for March 13 and March 27, 2019

Complete Streets Prioritization Projects – Phase 3 of Complete Streets has been submitted to the State for approval.

Director Joe Lynch will go before the Board of Selectmen to give a breakdown of the Mass Works project. Sidewalks from Town Hall to Manor and from Main Street up Wattaquadock to the ball field are anticipated. The loop through the ball field to Mechanic Street /school grounds will be completed. The turning lane at Wattaquadock will fit four cars in queue. Three crosswalks will be at the Main/Wattaquadock intersection: 2 across Main, 1 across Wattaquadock.

Line painting is scheduled for May. Leslie will remind DPW to paint West Berlin Road and the channeling lines that were left off the last painting schedule.

February speed data – the data seems consistent from month to month, with some fluctuations in number of cars with the seasons.

Wide mouth and 'Y' intersections inventory – The committee reviewed and finalized the "Wide and Y" intersections inventory. (See attachment) Mary will share the committee's inventory with Joe Lynch.

Meeting with Police Chief Nelson – The committee's next meeting is on the morning of April 22nd at the Safety Building, 10:30am.

Create Action Items List- Committee started composing a list of action items to work on moving forward. Some considerations were:

- Classic Pizza- why are there no boundaries to the parking area, jersey barriers or something comparable?
- Bolton Orchards close off driveway on Main Street closest to intersection (Complete Streets item #12)
- Bicycle and Pedestrian safety- Implement Safe Routes to School programs in schools
- Lowering speed limits in the center of town need for a speed study
- No left turns- Identify roads for safety and to ease congestion
- Second exit at Florence Sawyer School
- Town signage list

The committee will work more on developing and prioritizing the action list.
