

BOARD OF HEALTH
TOWN OF BOLTON
RULES AND REGULATIONS

Governing the collection, transportation and keeping of garbage, offal or other offensive substances in the Town of Bolton, adopted by the Board of Health on April 24, 1984. These rules and regulations supersede all previous regulations.

1. Permit Requirements:

All licenses or permits issued under these regulations by the Board of Health shall expire annually on the first day of May unless otherwise specified. The Board will establish fees for permits on an annual basis. The Board reserves the right to revoke any license or permit at any time.

No person shall hold more than one permit during any permit holding period.

Any permit holder whose permit has been revoked cannot be issued a new permit for a period of three years by the board of Health.

2. Collection of Garbage, Offal of Other Offensive Substances:

No person shall collect garbage, offal or other offensive substances in the Town of Bolton or transport garbage, offal, or other offensive substances through the streets of Bolton without first obtaining a permit from the Board of Health and complying with all rules and regulations of the Board of Health in connection therewith. All vehicles and/or containers used for transporting garbage, offal or other offensive substances through the streets of Bolton shall be watertight, securely covered to prevent spillage and odors and shall be kept clean so as not to cause a nuisance by reason of noisome odors or attraction of insects.

3. Keeping of Garbage, Offal or Other Offensive Substances:

Wherever garbage, offal and other offensive substances is kept, it shall be put in such containers as not to cause a nuisance by reason of odors or attraction of insects. All such containers shall be securely covered at all times and thoroughly cleaned and disinfected periodically.

4. Penalty:

Whoever violates any of the provisions of these regulations shall be punished by a fine of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per day for each separate violation.
