- 1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm.

- 5. Main Street Tree Damage: Two trees have been cut into significantly due to Mass works project D. Lowe has been made aware that these trees, if they die within the next two years, will need to be replaced. The Tree Warden will be installing two new trees at Pan Cemetery.
- 6. Scout Project Update: none
- 7. **Keyes Farm Update**: B. Busch will contact Bob Pace for an update. The town received pictures of the plaque that was given to the Bonazolli family.
- **8. NRHD Certificate Frames:** Members decided on a plain black frame with a white mat. Three frames have been purchased but additional frames can be purchased if needed down the road.
