

Join Bolton Trails Committee for an Earth Day Hike Oak Trail Circuit

Parking: Parking Area on shoulder of Ballville Road. Please do not obstruct roadway.

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained rain is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained rain is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water, wear long pants, rain gear if applicable, bug repellent and closed toed shoes.

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

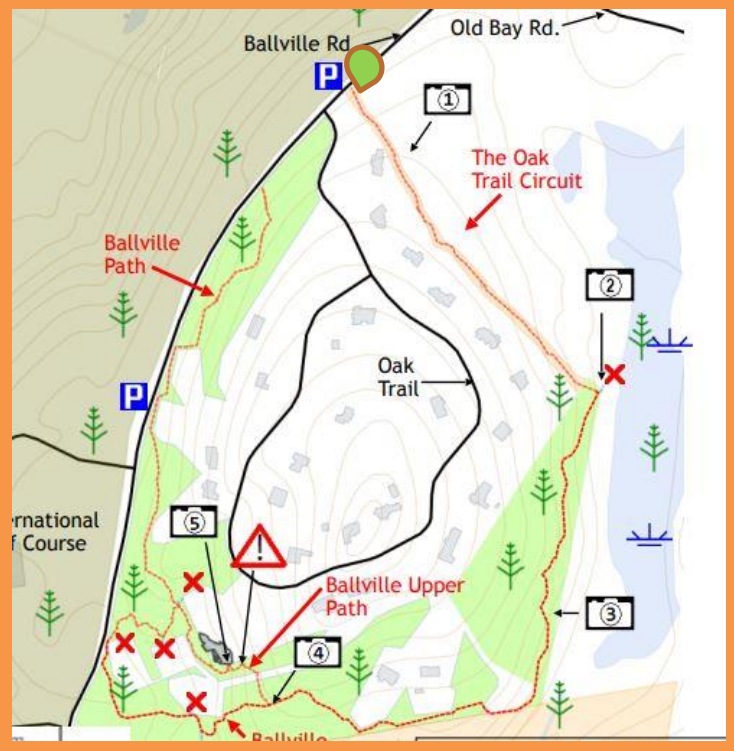
Pet Policy: Pets must be on leash. This is a narrow trail at points between private property and agricultural fields. These are working agricultural fields and are not open to the public. Dogs are not permitted to be accessing the fields.

Celebrate Earth Day by joining the Bolton Trails Committee rain or shine for a walk through the newly refreshed Oak Trail Circuit.

The walk will begin at the trail head located off of Ballville Road at the intersection of Oak Trail. This will be a loop trail through the property. Please remain on marked trails. Terrain is moderate to challenging due to traversing areas with outcrops, and some steep grades.

Come explore this 2-mile loop, see local wildlife, and explore a small rock cave!
