Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained precipitation is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained precipitation is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water, and appropriate footwear.

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.


Pet Policy: Must be leashed.
