

Take a Walk on the Wild Side at Fyfeshire Dam Conservation Area

Event Date: Wednesday, December 21st 2022

Time: 12pm

Duration: ~1.5 hours



Parking: at trailhead in gravel area at trailhead off of Wattaquodock Hill Road. Please DO NOT obstruct roadway.

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained precipitation is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained precipitation is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to dress warm in layers, bring water, and appropriate footwear (areas of trail may be muddy).

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

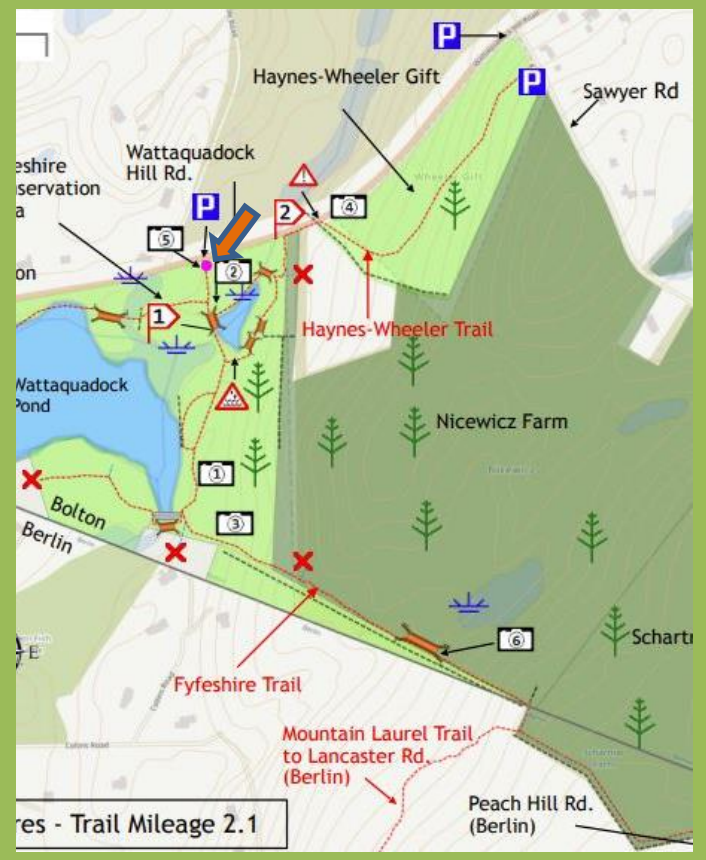
Pet Policy: Must be leashed. Must be picked up after.

The walk will begin at the trail head located off of Wattaquodock Hill Road (see map). This will be an out and back route. Terrain is moderate to challenging due to traversing areas with steep inclines and potentially wet sections. Wildlife sightings may include deer, various bird species, among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!
