Fyfeshire Dam Conservation Area to Peach Hill

Parking: Fyfeshire Dam Conservation Area trail head off of Wattaquaddock Hill Road

(Please do not block roadway or impede traffic)

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained precipitation is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained precipitation is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to dress in layers, bring water, and appropriate footwear (areas of trail may be muddy).

Pet Policy: Must be leashed. Must be picked up after.

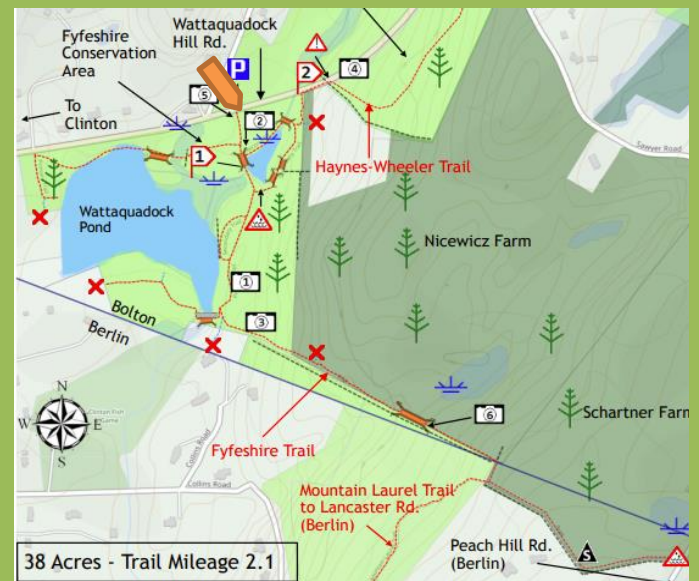
