

INVITATION FOR RE-BID
TOWN OF BOLTON, MASSACHUSETTS
Bolton Public Library Plumbing Repairs

Sealed bids are hereby invited for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment necessary for the Replacement of the Sanitary Sewer at the Bolton Public Library.

SEALED GENERAL RE-BIDS will be accepted at the office of the Department of Public Works, 12 Forbush Mill Road, until 11:00 am, local time, on Monday February 12, 2024 at which time the bids received will be opened and read aloud.

Project Description: The Work includes replacement of the sanitary sewer line under the floor of the library, extension of the existing sewer line outside of the building, associated plumbing and restoration of library including carpet and tile repair/replacement.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a certified check, payable to the Town of Bolton, or Bid Bond for five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid.

A Payment Bond and Performance Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, with corporate surety approved by the Town, will be required for the faithful performance of the Contract.

The **general bid must include** a valid Certificate of Eligibility and an Update Statement from the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) in the category of General Building Construction.

A **Pre-Bid visit** is scheduled for **February 1, 2024 at 2:00PM at 738 Main St, Bolton, MA 01740**

Bidder Questions are due **February 6, 2024 by 5:00PM.**

The project is subject to Minimum Wage rates as determined by the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development, Department of Labor Standards.

The project must be completed within 120 days from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages in the amount of \$100 per day may be applicable if work is not completed in this timeframe.

The Town of Bolton Town Administrator is the awarding authority.

The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities or informalities in the best interest of the Town.

The Town of Bolton is an EEP and encourages MBE and WBE to bid.
