Re: Long Hill Road Culvert Replacement
Summary of Bids

Bids were opened for the Long Hill Road Culvert Replacement Project at the appointed time of 11:00 am on March 27th.

Nine bids were submitted.

A preliminary review of the required documents indicates that all bidders were responsive.

Bids received range from a low of \$194,000 to a high of \$597,850, or an average of \$307,904.65, which is reasonable given the engineers estimate of probable cost. The average of the five lowest bids is \$301,108.60. The average of the three lowest bids is \$265,847.67.

The apparent low bidder is Kenefick Corporation with a bid of \$194,000.

We have completed our due diligence in the review of the bids and the capabilities of the apparent low bidder. I recommend that the bid be awarded to Kenefick Corp. and that a contract be executed for this project.
