Subject: Water usage by the new apartments

I would like to be made aware of the impact, if any, the new apartment water usage will have on my well. I believe that I am drawing water from the same aquifer.

I believe that Emerson and Sawyer are also on the same aquifer.

I have heard that the Manor is having problems with their water even before the construction of the apartments.

My well is on file. It is 235 feet deep.

Possibly restrictions on watering landscaping could be added to the conditions for the building. Maybe they could be ordered to have a shallow well that draws on the surface water or the brook rather than the aquifer would be appropriate if they need to water their landscaping.

Water is a resource we all need. Until we have town water we will need to learn to work together as a community.

Folks are having their wells dry up apparently due in part to the construction of new homes around them. We also seem to have no restrictions in town regarding watering landscaping by taking water from a aquifer.

I understand that the Master Plan May be taking into consideration the water needs of the town.

Please, consider appropriate conditions for the building of the apartments at 580 Main St. and please communicate to me regarding meetings that address the water usage at the new 580 Main St construction.
