Eligible* community members must have had their final Pfizer or Moderna vaccine in the 2-dose series at least 6 months prior to a booster, OR their single dose J&J vaccine at least 2 months prior to getting a booster.

- When: Wednesday 1/5/2022, 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM
- Where: St. Anthony Church Hall, 33 Chapel St Shirley MA 01464
- *Eligibility requirements: People 18 years and older can receive a Moderna booster shot 6+ months after completing their Pfizer or Moderna series. People 18 years and older can receive a Moderna booster shot 2+ months after receiving their J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine.
