

As part of our efforts to provide as much information and awareness as possible to the residents of Bolton regarding the Tennessee Gas Pipeline project, the Board of Selectmen have scheduled a meeting on this topic for Thursday, June 26<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 P.M. – 9:00 P.M. It is being held in the auditorium located in the Florence Sawyer School at 100 Mechanic Street in Bolton. This venue has been chosen due to the possibility of a much larger than normal attendance for a Board of Selectmen meeting. Attendance has been as high as 300+ people in other area communities.

The Board of Selectmen has invited representatives from Tennessee Gas to present their latest information on this proposed project. The meeting will begin with a 20 – 30 minute presentation by Tennessee Gas. This presentation will be followed by a Question & Answer period.
